PLEASE DO NOT COME EARLY.

Camp staff will not be ready for check-in until designated time.

Things to bring to check-in:

- 1. Spending money for camp store (if not paid online)
- 2. Balance of camper fee (unless fully paid online)
- 3. All medications, prescription and non-prescription

All spending money must be deposited with the business manager. Expenditures are tracked daily and any remaining money will be returned at the end of camp.

TUCK SHOP

E-MAIL SERVICE (incoming only)

Parents and friends may send e-mail to their camper during the week at no charge. E-mails will be delivered daily during rest hour.

<u>Instructions</u>: Sign into your UltraCamp account. In the task bar across the top, click on Additional Options. From the drop-down, click on E-mail a Camper. Select the camper's name from the list on your account. Put in subject, type your message, and click Send Message.

To allow those not on your account to send e-mail to your camper, click on Create Friend Accounts and follow the instructions.

Please limit your e-mails to your child to one per day. E-mails sent after 10 pm on Thursday may not be delivered, as Friday is a very busy day for our staff.

CHECKLIST FOR PACKING (Be sure to label everything)



- \Rightarrow twin sheets, blanket (or sleeping bag), and pillow
- \Rightarrow Sleeping bag (for sleeping outside under the stars one night)
- \Rightarrow Plastic ground cloth or something waterproof to sit on
- ⇒ Sleepwear and undergarments
- \Rightarrow Socks (required at all times)
- ⇒ Modest shorts and shirts (no spaghetti straps, bare tummies or shoulders; mid-thigh for length of shorts)
- \Rightarrow Jeans or long pants (may be required for certain activities)
- \Rightarrow Jacket or sweatshirt
- ⇒ 2 pair sneakers or closed-toe/closed-heel shoes (no sandals or flip flops, except in shower)
- ⇒ Swimwear (one piece for girls), beach towel, and sunscreen
- \Rightarrow Raingear (poncho, rain jacket, or umbrella)
- \Rightarrow Hat, Sunglasses
- \Rightarrow Water Bottle
- \Rightarrow Soap, wash cloths, and towels
- \Rightarrow Comb, brush, shampoo, other personal hygiene items
- \Rightarrow Toothbrush, toothpaste, plastic cup
- \Rightarrow Plastic bag for wet clothes
- \Rightarrow Bible, notebook, pen or pencil
- \Rightarrow Flashlight with extra batteries
- One stamped, pre-addressed envelope (campers are required to write a letter home on Monday)
- \Rightarrow Extra stationery and stamps (optional)
- ⇒ Something to do during rest hour (books, paper, puzzles, crayons)

Please do NOT bring:

Knives or weapons

Snacks for the cabin

Cell phones or electronics

- \Rightarrow Insect repellant (there are mosquitoes at camp)
- \Rightarrow Camera (optional)
- \Rightarrow Alarm clock (optional)
- \Rightarrow Drawstring bag (optional)

If for any reason your camper must leave before the scheduled departure time, a special permission slip must be completed by the parent/guardian and approved by the director before or during registration.

Campers are not encouraged to leave the camping session early.

Parents are welcome on the campgrounds during check-in and check-out times ONLY.

GETTING TO CAMP

From Interstate 88 or 80:

Take Route 26 north into Dixon. Continue on Route 26/Galena Rd through downtown Dixon. Proceed over the river. With McDonald's on your left, turn left at the stop light onto Route 2. Go past two more stop lights and a Shell gas station. Turn left onto Summit Ave. Then take an immediate right onto Reynoldswood Road. Follow Reynoldswood Road to the dining hall for registration.

From Sterling:

Take Route 2 North; it goes east toward Dixon. Just before entering Dixon, you'll descend on a large hill. After passing the Dixon city limits sign, turn right onto Summit Avenue. Then take an immediate right onto Reynoldswood Road. Follow Reynoldswood Road to the dining hall for registration.
